## **Packing, Shipping and Other Charges**

The *Kalinawa Art Foundation* takes great care to ensure your purchase of a piece of Indigenous Peoples visual art is received in the exact same condition as the artist intended. The packing process uses the best materials available and all packing is supervised by management. Our carrier, DHL, is a leader in the global shipping industry. Prices cited below are listed in Philippine pesos, but settlement via other currencies may be possible upon request.

### **Packing**

Each item is wrapped in foam or paper. The box or crate is lined with foam, and bubble pack is placed between the foam and the art. These expenses are not included in the purchase price or the shipping rate, and are subject to change:

- Envelope: 350 pesos - 16 inches x10 inches. Recommended for textiles only.
- Box 1: 200 pesos – 6 inches high x 6 inches wide x 6 deep with a maximum weight 2 pounds or 1 Kg
- Box 2: 250 pesos - 12 inches high x 12inches wide x 12 deep with a maximum weight 5 pounds or 2.2 Kg
- Box 3: 300 pesos – 18”inches high x 24 inches wide x 12 inches deep with a maximum weight 20 pounds or 9 Kg
- Standard picture crate: 500 pesos – 24 inches high x 36 inches wide x 2 inches deep
- Custom crating: 2000 pesos per cubic meter.

### **Customs, Duty or other costs**

Custom duties and taxes, fuel surcharges, 10% administration charges and other extra charges are not included in the rates.

## Insurance

Shipping insurance is offered through our carrier DHL.

Shipments with a value declared at \$100 and above may be, at the discretion of the purchaser, covered with insurance for premium computed at 2% of the declared value plus 12% VAT. In case of loss or damage, refund would be 100% of the declared value.

Refund for shipments without insurance (with a declared value of \$100 and above) is only up to \$100, in case of loss or damage.

## Other Shipping Options

The following are possible other options to ship other than DHL. Note should be made that no guarantee or insurance are available. These prices do not include packing and are for indicative purposes only, as they are subject to change:

- **Parcel post:** National (Philippines) or international - posted rates plus 10 % handling and package.
- **Consolidated sea cargo:** National (Philippines) at 4500 pesos per cubic meter or international 250 pesos per Kg (2.2 pounds)
- **Regular air cargo:** National (Philippines) at 250 pesos per Kg or international at 450 pesos per Kg (2.2 pounds)
- **Express air cargo:** National (Philippines) or international at 900 pesos per Kg (2.2 pounds)
